It's a bit like seeing things through new eyes and hearing things through new ears, and I find it to be wonderfully refreshing. That was especially the case after this last ministry trip as we listened to so many testify of the significance of the ministry. Several people from Denver and even some from Texas joined us for a "Freedom Gathering" in Roswell, New Mexico. One of those was Katie, our youngest daughter. I've asked her to give you her account of what took place there; I hope you enjoy it.

Hello DMI partners and friends! Katie here, Deborah and Harvey's daughter. This is a fun change of pace for me to get to speak to you guys directly; I am usually more of a behind-the-scenes person as far as DMI operations are concerned. My usual jobs involve planning the layout for *The Deborah Report* as well as web site design and maintenance. I am also an Associate Pastor at Harvey and Deborah's home church, Crossfire.

This month, I am privileged to write to you because I recently had the opportunity to travel with Mom and Dad on one of their adventures for the Lord. We thought it might be fun for you to hear about this adventure through the eyes of a behind-the-scenes kind of person, and someone else who benefits from your partnership with us, and sees the results!

Last month, Harvey and Deborah returned from what we have termed, "The Remnant Circuit," the ministry meetings in College Station, Texas, and Roswell, New Mexico. My family and I, along with several members of our church drove to meet them for the tail end of the circuit in Roswell. Early in June, the Holy Spirit planted an impression in Deborah's heart that these meetings would be crucial in what He is doing in our ministry's area of influence in His end-time move of the Spirit. She felt it was crucial that as many of our church members as possible be present and contribute in any way that the Lord might call on us and asked us all to pray about joining them.

As I lifted this possibility up to the Lord, I felt many of my Western tendencies kick in. We had just returned from vacation. How would we afford it? Also, it was only one month away. It bumped up against my sensibilities for how long it takes to plan something like this. After all, He is God. He could give us a little more notice! However, the short-timing was confirmation in itself that we were supposed to go. In this end-time move of the Spirit, I have seen the Lord increasingly expect His people to turn on a dime. ***He desires a closeness with us and a willingness of heart that doesn't require Him to give us a year's notice***

when He wants to do something new. Instead He desires an attitude of, "Here am I, send me."

So, we said yes, made plans to attend, and stood in faith for the provision. Sure enough, God is faithful and the provision came through. One month later we found ourselves on the road to Roswell, excited to see what God had in store.

Upon arriving, we immediately felt a bonding with the people of Gateway Church International, the church that hosts Harvey and Deborah regularly. Also, the leadership and many church members from College Heights Assembly of God in College Station, Texas continued on to the Roswell meetings as well. We were all aware that the Lord had a divine purpose for the three churches to be present at these meetings.

Harvey and Deborah spoke Friday night with a message from the Holy Spirit about getting out of negative cycles. These hold us captive to repeating dysfunctional and problematic behaviors which end in repetitive, unwanted circumstances. There was corporate deliverance from problematic perspectives and it was very powerful.

Over the next few days, the Lord delivered His message to His remnant through Harvey and Deborah, Debbie Tran (of Vietnam), Pastor Rick and Linda Rapp (Gateway), and Pastor Tommy and Suzy Thompson (College Heights). Although He had many mouthpieces, the message that came across was strikingly similar and resoundingly clear.

The Lord desires that we, as the body of Christ and His remnant, be free from our negative cycles and the junk in our lives so that we can focus on His Kingdom. However, we cannot wait to focus on His Kingdom until our lives look the way we want them to look. If we allow ourselves to put the things of the Kingdom on hold until our circumstances settle down, we will be waiting until Jesus returns and we will miss out on being a part of manifesting His Kingdom on earth in the here and now. There will always be family drama, professional drama,



and political drama on this earth until Jesus returns. We cannot wait for these things to subside before we make ourselves available to the Lord to do what He has for us to do.

The Lord is also challenging our ideas of the way He does things. He wants to be free to do things in a new way and have His body right there with Him, moving in tandem, instead of pointing out to Him that He needs to stick with what worked in the past. (Or in my case, requesting a year's notice when He's going to move).

The results of this willingness and flexibility are very rewarding. The outcome of these meetings was multi-dimensional and incredibly weighty. Some very important things were established in the Spirit.

The Lord has been preparing these three churches to come into unity for several years. These meetings were the outcome of that preparation as the congregations were able to experience a unity of purpose and spirit that were almost palpable. *We truly became family. It sounds very sweet in the practical sense, but in the spiritual sense, it's very powerful.*

Remember in the Bible that entire nations were built on family – for example the tribes of Israel were each a family name. Also, the family was a war unit. Abraham's family went to war on behalf of Lot when he was captured. We can apply God's idea of family to our own families, to our churches, and to those He has us connected with in the body of Christ. He desires for us to be that tight, with love as strong as family love, and a willingness to defend our territory and advance our family name (His name) and purposes with ferocity.

Another result of these meetings was an impartation for tri-generational ministry anointing. In this end-time move, the Lord desires to release three generations into ministry simultaneously. The old way of having the most mature generation minister and handing off the reigns at retirement is gone. The new way of having all ages armed with a ministry mentality brings a three-generational cord that is not easily broken, and opens up the avenues, benefits, and giftings presented in all three generations for God to use.

I was blessed to be a part of releasing this ministry anointing as three generations of my family were welcomed to the platform to impart this to those present at the meetings. I have also been blessed to watch the outcome of this new way in action. My children take ministry very seriously, and I have already seen the affect they have on the world around them. This is especially

evident when the adults around them take their gifts seriously, helping to put them into action, instead of assuming it's all to be saved up for adulthood.

Another important assignment was for our intercessors and prophets that came with us on this journey. The Lord had an assignment for them to bring the land in Roswell into alignment with Him. God has a destiny for every part of His creation - the people *and* the land where they reside. The enemy has a counterfeit destiny for creation as well. Part of our job as ministers of His covenant is to help bring His creation back into alignment with Him.

The Bible says in Romans 8:20-22, "For the creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed. For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the children of God." One of the assignments our intercessors found they had been tasked with was freeing the land in that area from the counterfeit destiny that the enemy had planned. They accomplished this through prayer, prophetic acts, and declarations. The result is a creation free from "frustration," able to show the glory of God, and be territory that is returned to the Kingdom.

Overall, the trip was very weighty. There were countless small things and several big things and many in between that the Lord accomplished through it all. We always want to communicate even the smallest things to you as partners so that you can know the full ramifications of your willingness to partner with us, but that would require writing a book for each trip!

We also desire that you would reap the full benefits of partnering with us, *that the things the Lord is doing through this ministry in various places would take root in your lives as well, because you are a part of our roots.* We know that God is faithful to return fruit to your lives from the seed you have sown in this ministry.

In addition, I hope that this glimpse into this ministry trip gives you a taste of what the Lord is doing and what He wants to do through you as well. I believe that is the new normal for the way He is doing things, expecting the unexpected, being willing to do things that conflict with our way of doing things, or the accepted way of doing things in order to honor Him above the traditions and wisdom of man. This is the direction He is taking His remnant, His family unit in these last days. I pray that you experience the joys and rewards of this as you sow into His Kingdom and align with His purposes!†
